

#### **About the Campaign**

Fnd the Wait Kansas is a statewide issue campaign working to educate Kansans about why we need to take bold action to end all the Lists Waitina on Developmental Disability (DD) Waiver for HCBS (Home Community Based Services). The End the Wait Campaign is a collaborative project of the Disability Rights Center of Kansas (DRC) and numerous stakeholders.

#### **Quick Facts**

- 2,400 = number of
  Kansans with
  Developmental
  Disabilities on the
  "unserved" DD
  Waiting List. These are
  people who are
  forced to wait and
  receive NO DD Waiver
  services.
- 55 months (over 4.5 years) = Amount of time the person at the front of the unserved DD Waiting List has been forced to wait without services.
- 1,013 = Number of Kansans on the "underserved" waiting list. These are people who have cleared the first waiting list – the "unserved" wait list – only to find out that they must stand in a

- second line to receive all the services they need.
- 32 months (over 2.6 years) = Average amount of time people wait on the "underserved" waiting list.
- Amount of time
  Kansans with
  developmental
  disabilities may have
  to wait to clear both
  waiting lists and
  receive the lifesustaining services
  they need.
- 1,100 = number of the additional Kansans with Developmental Disabilities who are waiting for state services or supports (on top of the "under" and "unserved" numbers above).
