## Cash/Employment Assistance

SRS offers employment services to help adults get a job and temporary cash assistance for their family while they are receiving services. To qualify, the adult must have at least one child under the age of 18 or be expecting a child. Disabled adults without children may also qualify for cash assistance.

## Food Assistance

Food Assistance (also known as Food Stamps) is available to eligible persons for use in purchasing food from local grocery stores. Families, single individuals or groups of individuals who live and eat together, whose income and resources are low, and who meet certain basic program requirements may qualify.

## Child and Adult Protective Services

If you suspect that a child or an adult in Kansas is being abused or neglected, please contact the Kansas Protection Report Center:

- In Kansas but outside Topeka, call 1-800-922-5330
- In Topeka or outside of Kansas and cell phone users, call (785) 296-0044
- In an emergency, call local law enforcement.

When a report is received an initial assessment is completed to determine if further investigation is needed by SRS or law enforcement and appropriate services are provided.

## Children and Family Services

SRS offers a variety of family centered services designed to build on family strengths by providing the supports necessary to maintain children safely in their own home. Services are provided directly or through community based providers.

Programs include:

- Child protective services
- Family Support Services
- Family Preservation
- Foster Care
- Independent Living/Life Skills
- Post Adoption Searches

## Child Care Assistance

Child Care Assistance is available to low income working families with children under the age of 13 to use toward the cost of child care from their chosen provider. Assistance is provided to parents who are responsible for paying child care providers. Most parents must also pay a part of their child care costs themselves.

## Child Support Enforcement

Child support enforcement assists families with children by legally establishing paternity, finding absent parents, and getting and/or enforcing orders for child support payments and health insurance coverage. A customer service call center is available to assist individuals with their questions about child support. The call center phone number is 1-888-757-2445.

## Home and Community Based Services

Home and Community Based Services or HCBS enable people to remain in their home rather than in an institutional setting.

HCBS include

- Autism Waiver,
- Developmental Disability Services,
- Physical Disability Services,
- Severe Emotional Disturbance Waiver,
- Technology Assisted Children Waiver, and
- Traumatic Brain Injury Waiver.

## Employment Help for Persons with Disabilities

Rehabilitation Services help people with disabilities become gainfully employed and self sufficient. Counselors work in partnership with people to assess their skills and interests, develop plans for employment and acquire the services they need to become employed.

## Health Services

Mental health and substance abuse treatment programs are provided to low income Kansans to help cover the cost of such services. For mental health services please call Kansas Health Solutions at 1-888-547-2878. For substance abuse services, please call ValueOptions at 1-866-645-8216. Kansas Health Solutions and ValueOptions are contracted by SRS to ensure consumers are able to access the services they need in a timely manner.
